INTRODUCTION TO PERMACULTURE/CERTIFICATION

WITH INSTRUCTOR JOSH CARMICHAEL

PERMACULTURE IS THE ART AND SCIENCE OF DESIGN THAT APPLIES PATTERNS IN NATURE TO THE DEVELOPMENT OF HUMAN AND NATURAL ENVIRONMENTS.

This course provides participants a basic understanding of the principles and applications of permaculture in their lives and communities. It is a hands-on, design and build forum that includes guest lectures from local environmental leaders and sustainability site tours and a 2 day camp-out at Quail Springs Permaculture Farm.

Participants become certified as a Permaculture Design Trainee and receive a Permaculture Design Certificate recognized worldwide.
